Well we were supposed to return to Papua New Guinea last Tuesday, but at the last minute we had to change our plans. Please pray as I (Kim) need surgery on my neck. Next Monday the 11th, the neurosurgeon will be removing a disk in my neck and fusing two vertebrae together. Over the last couple of months, I have been experiencing a good deal of pain and the resultant sleep deprived nights. Lord willing, this surgery will eliminate the problem and the pain. If all goes well, after recovery and some PT we should be able to return to PNG in January 2022 – that is our plan. But we continue to experience what Proverbs tells us, that we make our plans, but the Lord directs our steps. We know this is God's "Plan A" for us –
